 Special Note: Recommendation letters are prohibited from family members and/or relatives.
- 6. Applicant must provide a wallet-size self-photo in business attire.
- 7. Applicant must write a one-page essay (double spaced) on a pre-selected topic listed in the application.
- 8. Application and all supporting documentation must be USPS Postmarked by 11:59pm (Central Standard Time) Wednesday, March 24, 2024. Late applications will NOT be accepted, NO EXCEPTIONS!
